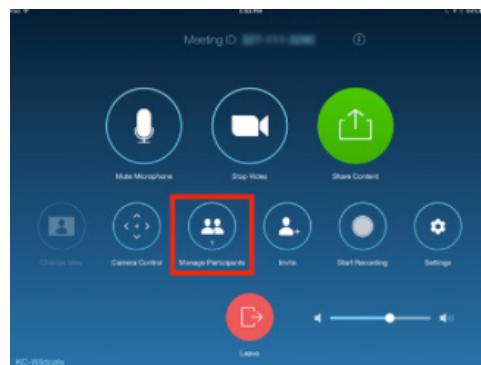


Using a SmartPhone as a Webcam

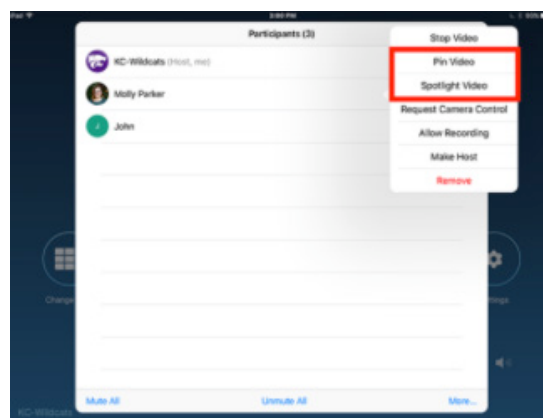
If you don't have a webcam and you'd like to show a demo (like on a sewing machine), you can set up your smartphone, iPad or other smart device as a webcam.

SET UP:

1. Email yourself the Zoom meeting link you'll be using.
2. Open the email on your smartphone or smart device, and click the Zoom meeting link.
3. You'll be prompted to download the Zoom app, if you haven't already.
4. Once you're in the Zoom meeting. On your smartphone or device, tap "Manage Participants" on the Zoom Room Controller.



5. Tap the Host or Participant's name > tap "Pin" or "Spotlight Video."

6. Congratulations! You can use your smartphone or device like a webcam, and this is what students will see during the Zoom meeting.
